Lesson 3 – First Peter 2:11-3:12 – "Honorable Living"

I <u>Live HONORABLY – VV 2:11 - 12</u>.

Verse 11.

The world, the flesh, and the devil are at war with us, so God calls us to **RESIST** the lusts we used automatically to give into and that constantly bear down on us. (CF: I John 2:15-17 and James 4:1-2)

Verse 12.

"Conduct" refers to your "MANNER OF LIFE." "Good" behavior produces "Good" works.

II Submission as CITIZENS – VV 2:13 – 17.

Verses 13-15. We submit to human government—not to escape punishment due for disobedience—but for the "*Lord's sake*." (CF: Romans 13:1-7.)

Genesis 9:6, "Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed. For in the image of God He made man." The role of Human Government is to **PUNISH** the wrong and **UPHOLD** the right. Note: There's a *caveat* to always obeying the government. (CF: Acts 4:18-20)

Verses 16-17.

Do not use your liberty as a "VEIL for vice." God requires our submission as citizens of our world.

III Submission as SERVANTS – VV 2:18 – 25.

We are to obey our earthly Boss because this shows **GRACE** under fire. Submit first to Jesus Christ—our Shepherd and our True Boss.

IV Submission in the FAMILY – VV 3:1 - 7.

Wives are to be submissive to their husbands who—whether a believer or not—is the God-ordained representative of *The Divine Shepherd and Overseer*.

Men, according to godly knowledge—treat your wife with respect and meet her needs. Men, if you don't show respect to your wives you are not submitting to God, so don't bother praying.

V Submission in the BODY – VV 3:8 – 12.

First, Verses 10-12. (FR: Psalm 34:12-16)

If you would love life, Then practice these standards:

- A. Keep your tongue from evil.
- B. Do not repay evil for evil.
- C. Seek peace and pursue it.

Second, Verses 8-9.

Verse 8 tells us how to keep our tongue from evil:

- A. Be in **HARMONY** with one another
- B. Be **SYMPATHETIC** to one another.
- C. Be **LOVING** to one another.
- D. Be **COMPASSIONATE** with one another.
- E. Be **HUMBLE**!

Verse 9 explains how to turn away from evil and do good:

- A. **Don't return evil for evil**. Don't exercise **PAY-BACK** for any evil you might suffer.
- B. Seek peace and pursue it. SPEAK WELL of all, even the hard to get along with.
- C. We inherit a blessing. If we exercise these Christian Standards, *Then* we inherit a blessing—God hears our prayers for we have drawn closer to God and better know His Will.

Summing Up: They'll know we are Christians by our LOVE!
