- swarmed by the religious leaders (4:1-2)
 - + priests
 - + captain of the guard
 - + Sadducees
- the apostles arrested...but not the gospel (4:3-4)
- getting the conversation started... (4:5-7)

2. The apostle's answer

- explicitly exposed their guilt... implicitly exposed their impending judgment (4:8-10)
- unredeemed man's greatest enemy
- Jesus is the *only* way to deal with our sin and guilt (4:11-12)
 - objection #1:What about the person who is sincere in his beliefs?
 - objection #2:How could God be so narrow to offer only one way?
 - objection #3:

 It's so arrogant to say your way is the only way!
- Jesus' statements about Himself
