

Genesis 1:2-25

Lucifer ruled the earth in verse 1. Then he was cast out and now he is raging against mankind.

- 2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. *Lucifer ruled the wonderful beautiful earth from day one for how long, we don't know. Even scientists don't know how old the earth is. God destroyed the original form of the earth with some catastrophic event. He destroyed it and earth became a big mess. Even scientists can prove that. God's face brooded upon the waters. He looked over it for a time, how long we don't know.*
- 3 ¶ And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. *The sun was already created in the first creation. Bible scholars call this the re-creation. God allowed the sunlight to reach earth again at this point.*
- 4 And God saw the light, that *it was* good: and God divided the light from the darkness.
- 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day. *This is the recreation. He lets light start shining through this void after He cast Satan and Satan's angels out. Day and night we think it means a 24-hour day, the earth's daily rotation is set up now.*
- 6 ¶ And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.
- 7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which *were* under the firmament from the waters which *were* above the firmament: and it was so.
- 8 And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day. *This is where God takes the water that was around the earth at that time and separates it into heavens and oceans. He put water up into the atmosphere and left some down on the earth, and the area in between is called heaven. There are 3 heavens: 1st: atmospheric, 2nd: out where the stars are, and 3^d: where God resides.*
- 9 ¶ And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry *land* appear: and it was so.
- 10 And God called the dry *land* Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that *it was* good.
- 11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, *and* the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed *is* in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.
- 12 And the earth brought forth grass, *and* herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed *was* in itself, after his kind: and God saw that *it was* good.
- 13 And the evening and the morning were the third day. *God now separates the water on the land into one place. In science, we can see where all the land was gathered into one place. At this time, all the land is one mass and all the water is one mass. We do know from a few scriptures we have that when Lucifer ruled earth, he had cities and it was a paradise. Anything else is a speculation. God is getting things set up for mankind to live on earth. He set up the land, the water, the fruit trees, and the herbs. God sets up the fruit trees as food. The peach tree bears peaches only; the apple tree bears only apples. We are now seeing why Lucifer is in such a rage against mankind: because God took away everything from Lucifer and gave it to mankind. This is why Lucifer roams the earth seeking weak people to devour. We have a choice to let Satan destroy us or let Jesus Christ save us. There is no choice to not pick one or the other. - 14 ¶ And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: *God set up the orbits and rotations so that it would evolve into the months, seasons, days, years. The Bible says these seasons will remain forever. There will be slight variations, but you will always know when it is winter, summer, spring and fall.*
- 15 And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.

- 16 And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: *he made the stars also. God made the sun and moon shine great enough for man to see them, but they were already created in the first creation.*
- 17 And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, *this is the reason the sun, moon, and stars are there: to give light to the earth.*
- 18 And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that *it was good. God likes what He created.*
- 19 And the evening and the morning were the fourth day. *The ecosystem is now set up and ready for new life to be installed.*
- 20 ¶ And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl *that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.*
- 21 And God created great whales, and every living creature that moves, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that *it was good.*
- 22 And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth.
- 23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day. *This is when God made the animals: birds, fish, mammals, reptiles. God made everything in sequence so that each thing He brings forth will sustain the next thing He brings forth. Man messes things up. God has everything perfect, working in harmony.*
- 24 ¶ And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so. *Genetic engineering is not allowed, says God right here. Each kind is to be with their own, to reproduce their own. There are mutations and variations, but there is no evolution. Monkeys produce monkeys, not men. Gay marriage is wrong because the human race cannot breed with the same gender. We are told right here to bring forth the living creature after his kind.*
- 25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creeps upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that *it was good. Man is the crowning point of God's creation. God really likes His creation, and so do we.*
