## God's Role in Human Government?

- A. God is the source of all political power—13:1
  - 1. God is absolutely sovereign over man—Jeremiah 27:5
  - 2. God delegates power to men—John 19:10-11
  - 3. "Power corrupts; Absolute power corrupts absolutely!"
- B. God establishes various human governments—13:1
  - 1. God established human government
  - 2. God fills the positions with men and women of His choosing. Daniel 2:20-21; 5:20-21
  - 3. God's choice for us?

## C. God ordains the functions of government—13:2-4

- 1. The form of government not ordained.
- 2. The functions of government ARE ordained by God.
  - a. To promote what is morally good, upright, beneficial
    - 1) Laws do legislate morality.
    - 2) Government sets limits on morality
  - b. To protect through punishment of evildoers--13:3-4
- D. God holds us accountable for our citizenship—13:1-7
  - 1. General: "bring judgment on ourselves" 13:2
  - 2. Specific: Three Responsibilities
    - a. Submit
