THREE REQUESTS AND A BENEDICTION 1 THESSALONIANS 5:25-28

I. FIRST REQUEST TO RESOLVE—"Brethren, pray for us" (Vs 25) (i.e. Pray for those that minister on your behalf!)

- A. Why Pray For Them?
 - 1. Because They Long For Your Prayers!

 Romans 15:30 Now I beseech you, brethren, for the

 Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the love of the Spirit,

 that ye strive together with me in your prayers to God

 for me;

Ephesians 6:18-20

Colossians 4:3 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:

2. Because They Labor For Your Profit!

1 Corinthians 7:35 And this I speak for your own profit...

1 Corinthians 10:33 Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved.

3. Because They Live As Your Pattern! Jesus told his disciples... Follow me!

1 Corinthians 4:16 Wherefore I beseech you, be ye followers of me.

1 Corinthians 11:1 Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.

Philippians 3:17 Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

1 Thessalonians 1:6; 2 Thessalonians 3:7

- 4. Because They Lookout For Your Protection!

 Hebrews 13:17 Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.
- B. How To Pray For Them.
 - 1. Pray For Their Work! (2 Thessalonians 3:1)
 - 2. Pray For Their Safety! (2 Thessalonians 3:2)
- II. SECOND REQUEST TO RECEIVE—"GREET ALL THE BRETHREN WITH AN HOLY KISS." (Vs 26) i.e. Express brotherly love to all the brethren as was the custom!
- III. THIRD REQUEST TO READ—"I charge you by the LORD that this epistle be read unto all the holy brethren." (Vs 27)
- IV. THE BENEDICTION—"The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen." (Vs 28)

1 Peter 5:10-11 10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you. 11 To him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
