### C. The ASPECTS of FORGIVENESS.

1. There is \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness before God, as the judge, when a sinner believes the Gospel. (Romans 4:1-8; Acts 10:43; 13:38-39; Colossians 1:14)
2. There is \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness with God, as your Heavenly Father, when a saint confesses his known sins as the Holy Spirit convicts. (Psalm 51; Psalm 86:5; Prov.28:13; 1 John 1:9)
3. There has been (Micah 7:18-20; Psalm 130:8; Day of Atonement) and will be \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness from God for Israel when the Messiah (Jesus Christ) comes to set up His future, earthly, promised kingdom involving national \_\_\_\_\_. (Dan. 9:24-27; Zech.12:9-12)
4. There is to be \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness toward others, especially other believers.
  - Forgiveness relationally means to have no personal vendetta against the person but to have released or given over the offender to the only righteous Judge, the Lord, to deal with the offender as He pleases.
  - This is to be done \_\_\_\_\_. (Mark 11:25)
  - This may need to be done \_\_\_\_\_. (Luke 17:3)
  - This should be done \_\_\_\_\_. (Luke 17:3-4)
  - This may involve a \_\_\_\_\_ by the offended. (Luke 17:3a)
  - This will involve \_\_\_\_\_ by the offender and perhaps \_\_\_\_\_ if needed. (Luke 17:3-4; 2 Cor.7:11)

When you are unwilling to forgive another...

- 1) You \_\_\_\_\_ the GRACE OF GOD through BITTERNESS. (Heb.12:15)
  - 2) You \_\_\_\_\_ to the ENEMY OF GOD in your life. (Ephesians 4:26-27)
  - 3) You \_\_\_\_\_ the SPIRIT OF GOD who seeks to produce LOVE in your life. (Eph. 4:30-31)
  - 4) You fail to \_\_\_\_\_ the FORGIVENESS OF GOD you have been undeservedly given because of JESUS CHRIST. (Eph. 4:32-5:2)
  - 5) You \_\_\_\_\_ your FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD in your daily walk. (1 John 1:6-10)
5. There is to be \_\_\_\_\_ forgiveness when a believer who has been church disciplined or is guilty of public sin later repents and desires to be restored to the fellowship of a local church. (1 Cor.5:1-5; 2 Cor.2:4-11)

4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote to you, with many tears, not that you should be grieved, but that you might know the love which I have so abundantly for you.

5 But if anyone has caused grief, he has not grieved me, but all of you to some extent-- not to be too severe.

6 This punishment which was inflicted by the majority is sufficient for such a man, 7 so that, on the contrary, you ought rather to forgive and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one be swallowed up with too much sorrow.

8 Therefore I urge you to reaffirm your love to him.

9 For to this end I also wrote, that I might put you to the test, whether you are obedient in all things.

10 Now whom you forgive anything, I also forgive. For if indeed I have forgiven anything, I have forgiven that one for your sakes in the presence of Christ,

11 lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.
