**God's presence is known in the context of \_\_\_\_\_ (46:1)**

- Israel set out with all that he had (1a)
- Israel worshipped the Covenant keeping God at Beersheba (1b)

**God's presence is known through the \_\_\_\_\_ (46:2-4)**

- God spoke to Israel (2)
- Reminding Jacob that He is the covenant keeping God (3a)
- And therefore Jacob did not need to \_\_\_\_\_ going to Egypt (3b-4)
  - Because God would be with Jacob in Egypt making him a \_\_\_\_\_
  - Because God would bring Jacob back to the Promised Land
  - Because Joseph was truly alive

**God's presence is known through His gracious sovereign fulfillment of His \_\_\_\_\_ (46:5-27)**

- The covenant family moves to Egypt (5-7)
- The persons of the covenant family in Egypt (8-27)

**God's presence is known through the \_\_\_\_\_ associated with His promises (46:28-47:28)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Blessings: Jacob and Joseph are reunited (46:28-30)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Blessings:
  - Joseph prepares his brothers to meet Pharaoh (46:31-34)
  - Pharaoh meets Joseph's brothers and then father, granting them a portion of the best of the land (47:1-12)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Blessings: Joseph is used by God to provide for all of Egypt and his family during the famine (47:13-28)

**God's presence is known through the life of \_\_\_\_\_ (47:29-31)**

- Jacob's life of faith expressed itself with a persevering \_\_\_\_\_ on God's promise (29-31a)
- Jacob's life of faith expressed itself with an ongoing focus on \_\_\_\_\_ God (31b)
