 - B. Wrath Removed (vs. 21-23)
 - 1. Please hear this
 - 2. The Sovereign, Yahweh, Your God, the God of absolute justice defends His people
 - a. I have taken the cup removed
 - b. You will not drink of it again removed once for all Heb. 7:26-28; 9:11-15; 10:11-14
 - 3. Wrath will be removed from you and placed upon those who afflicted you Rev. 6:9-11; Col. 3:5-7; 1 Thess. 1:6-10
