# 32. Matthew 6:12 – 5<sup>th</sup> Petition to Lord's Prayer: Forgive Us Our Debts

The Manifesto of the King - Sermon on the Mount: The Christian's Religion

## I. WE ARE DEBTORS TO GOD

#### A. Sin as a Debt

#### **B. Sin is the Worst Debt** (Watson)

- 1. Because we have nothing to pay.
- 2. Because it is against an infinite majesty.
- 3. Because it is not a single, but a multiplied debt.
- **4. Because it is an inexcusable debt.** We cannot deny the debt. We cannot shift off the debt.
- 5. Because it carries men, if not paid, to a worse prison than upon earth.

### II. GOD DELIGHTS IN FORGIVING DEBTORS IN CHRIST

#### A. Christ Has Paid the Debt

- 1. Only Christ Can.
- 2. We owe Creator perfect obedience. But Christ obeyed perfectly
- 3. We owe God an infinite debt for sin against Him. But Christ has paid that debt perfectly.

### B. God delights in forgiving Debtors in Christ (Micah 7:18-19) God in Christ....

- 1. Delights in Mercy (18) to Forgive! Why?....because...
- 2. Pardons Iniquity—"lift it up" and "takes it away"!
- 3. Passes Over Transgression
- 4. No Longer Angry—Christ has taken eternal wrath in our place, now no condemnation to dread.
- 5. Has Compassion on Sinner! (19)—instead, looks upon sinner as does Beloved Son, for in Beloved
- 6. <u>Subdues our Iniquities</u>—not just justified before Him, but promise of sanctification/glorification!
- 7. Casts ALL Sins into Depths of Sea—never to be seen/float to surface to rise up in judgment against us!

#### C. So the non-Christian must pray for forgiveness

- 1. So, if you are still lost and hopeless in your sin—come to Christ, now!
- 2. Come to God in Christ, asking Him to forgive your debts

#### D. And the Christian must pray for forgiveness

- 1. Why—didn't you just say sins are permanently marked out? Yes, they are!
- 2. <u>How</u> <u>Daily</u>—as we <u>daily ask to be given bread</u>, should <u>daily ask to be forgiven of sin</u>.

  <u>Our</u>—as we <u>daily ask for bread for others</u>, should <u>daily ask for others</u> to know forgiveness <u>Confess</u>—as we <u>daily ask for specific needs (bread)</u>, should ask <u>forgiveness of specific sins</u>.
- 3. Remember we pray these petitions with sincere desire to obey and submit to them/answers

## III. WE ARE DEBTORS TO ONE ANOTHER

- A. We are forgiven, not made perfect
- B. Others will sin against you.
- C. You will sin against others.

#### IV. WE SHOULD DELIGHT IN FORGIVING OUR DEBTORS IN CHRIST

#### A. Reflects Christ

- 1. As God delights in Mercy, so should we imitate our Father in delighting in Mercy
- 2. As Christ exemplified such mercy and forgiveness, so should we imitate Christ!
- 3. Professes Christ outside Church
- 4. Preserves Unity within Church

#### B. Reflects that have been forgiven by Christ (6:14-15; 18:21-35)

- 1. Warning
- 2. Assurance
