

## “BUT GOD” Pt. 2

- Do you factor God into the equations of your life?
1. The “BUT GOD” of PERSONAL \_\_\_\_\_ in your time of need. (Genesis 20:3)
  2. The “BUT GOD” of DIVINE \_\_\_\_\_ when harm could come your way. (Gen. 31:7)
  3. The “BUT GOD” of SOVEREIGN \_\_\_\_\_ of individuals as well as the nation of Israel. (Genesis 45:8)
  4. The “BUT GOD” of FAITHFUL \_\_\_\_\_ in keeping His promises to a trusting child of God. (Genesis 50:24-26; Exodus 13:19; Joshua 24:32; Hebrews 11:22)
  5. The “BUT GOD” of GUARANTEED \_\_\_\_\_ ultimately in God’s presence for the believer. (Psalm 49:15)
    - How can you not be redeemed? (Psalm 49:6-9)
    - 4 Greek words for “redemption:
      - a. To be redeemed out of the slavemarket of sin involved a \_\_\_\_\_ that needed to be paid {agorazō}. (1 Cor. 6:20; Rev. 5:9)
      - b. To be redeemed out of the slavemarket of sin involved a \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ {lytroō}. (1 Peter 1:18-19; Titus 2:13-14)
      - c. To be redeemed out of the slavemarket of sin involved a \_\_\_\_\_, never to return to the slavemarket again {exagorazō}. (Galatians 3:13, 4:4-5)
      - d. To be redeemed out of the slavemarket of sin involved a \_\_\_\_\_, thorough transaction {apolytroō}. (Romans 3:24, 8:23)
    - Redemption involves both the believer’s \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. (Eph. 1:7, 13-14)
  6. The “BUT GOD” of UNFAILING \_\_\_\_\_ of heart to the believer who knows and embraces by faith God’s perspective when the wicked prosper without seeming consequences. (Psalm 73:24-28)

7. The “BUT GOD” of PROMISED \_\_\_\_\_ for the humble believer. (Psalm 75:4-7)

8. The “BUT GOD” of PENDING \_\_\_\_\_ for the unsaved fool. (Luke 12:20)
