- a) Are you living on credit instead of paying cash? Romans 13:7
- b) Are you delaying payments or paying the minimum amount? Romans 13:8
- c) Are you late on payments?
- d) Are you unable to tithe or save? Malachi 3:8
- e) Are you unable to pay taxes. Matthew 22:21
- f) Do you have a habit of <u>extravagant spending</u>? Proverbs 21:17
- g) Are you always looking for get-rich-quick ideas. Proverbs 21:5

# 2) Find the freedom from too much debt

- a) Commit to change decide to become debt free now Psalms 37:21
- b) Pay God first then yourself Matt. 3:8-11, Pr. 3:9-10, 1 Cor.16:1-2, Pr. 21:5
- c) Find out all I <u>own</u> and all I <u>owe</u>
- d) Have <u>a sale</u> 2 Kings 4:7
- e) Set up a repayment plan. Proverbs 21:5
- f) Add no new debt Hebrews 13:5
- g) Share my plan with my creditors. Proverbs 6:7
- h) Stick to it. Galatians 6:9
