Sermon: The Twelve Apostles Acts 1:12-26

Benediction: Ephesians 2:19-20

- I. The Apostles obeyed the Lord Jesus' commandment to wait in Jerusalem
- -see this commanded Acts 1:4
- -they were waiting for the baptism of the Holy Spirit upon the church

APPLICATION: let us be so obedient to Christ

-when the commandment is to stay and wait

- II. While they were waiting for the Spirit of Christ, they prayed
- -with one accord
- -both men and women
- -both notable and anonymous

APPLICATION: whenever we have no particular ministry task to do, let us pray

- III. While they were waiting for the Spirit of Christ, they set an important matter in order -the church needed an office filled
  - -there had been 12 apostles chosen
  - -one was gone, so another had to be chosen

Excursus: fate of Judas Iscariot -verse 17 after having been

- -numbered among the 12 apostles
- -part of the ministry
- -verse 25 he from his service and apostleship fell by transgression
- -verse 16 guided those who arrested Jesus
- -verse 18 with his wages a field was purchased
- -verse 18 there he killed himself, and somehow as his body fell, he burst open and his intestines gushed out
- -verse 19 all of this came to be known in Jerusalem
- -verse 19 because of this, and because the money was "blood money," the field came to be called Field of Blood
- -verse 25 he went to his own place

## **APPLICATION**

- -regarding church leaders who fall from their places in sin
- -regarding our own souls

-see how they proceed

- -(this is both according to OT model and consistent with the rest of NT practice and teaching) see Deut 1:12-15; Acts 6; Titus 1
- -the leader addresses the subject of the need to the people
- -the leader addresses the need in terms of the truth of scripture
  - -verse 16
  - -verse 20
    - -Psalm 69:25 Messianic psalm; this is an imprecatory prayer upon those who have mistreated Messiah
    - -Psalm 109:8 again, imprecatory prayer
- -the leader states the qualifications verse 21-22
  - -were with the Lord Jesus the whole time
    - -from His baptism of John
    - -to His ascension
  - -primarily so they can be witnesses of His resurrection
  - -secondarily so they will have full familiarity with His person and doctrine
  - -the original 11 did not already have these qualifications when chose, but would gain them during Jesus Christ's ministry
- -the congregation chooses men based on the qualification
- -the leader and the congregation pray

APPLICATION: whenever we are engaged in ministry, let us pray about it

- -IN THIS UNIQUE CASE, they cast lots
  - -because there was a certain number, with more than that number qualified
  - -because the baptism of the Holy Spirit was not yet upon them, and this was the old way of doing this
  - -because they had no right to choose an apostle, an office chosen by Christ
