"Great Revival!" – Part 1 Zechariah 12:10-14

A future great revival in Israel in which is seen a pattern of all true revival.

1. The Initiator of Revival: God Alone

"And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy..."

- (1) He pours forth the Spirit
 - A future work among the Jewish nation cf. Rom. 11:11-27
 - A work of rich abundance a great revival! "I will pour out"
 - A work which will impact the nations with gospel blessing
- (2) His Spirit powerfully ministers grace and mercy
 - "the Spirit" or "a spirit"?
 - Doesn't matter! Either way it is the work of the Spirit that is in view!
 - He ministers grace and mercy in showing men their need of mercy.
 - It is by His working that men are brought to cry out for mercy.
- 2. The Heart of Revival: Looking on Jesus
 - (1) Seeing Jesus with eyes of faith
 - Seeing and understanding Jesus' true identity
 - Seeing savingly

"...so that, when they look on me, on him whom they have pierced, they shall mourn for him..."

(2) Seeing Jesus as the true Son of God

"when they look **on me**, **on him** whom they have pierced"

- Understanding, believing that Jesus is God come in the flesh Jn. 1:12, 18
- To see Jesus is to see the Father Jn. 14:6-10

(3) Seeing Jesus as the Crucified one

"on him whom they have pierced"

- Understanding the significance of His death
 - Substitutionary atonement
 - "in my place, condemned, He stood"

- Knowing, owning their own guilt in His death

- As a nation Its literal (partial) fulfillment Jn. 19:37
 But refers to all the sufferings of Christ which culminated in His death
- As individuals

3. The Immediate Fruit of Revival: Repentance

- Deep Repentance "they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for an only child, and weep bitterly over him, as one weeps over a firstborn."

- Widespread Repentance "On that day the mourning in Jerusalem will be as great as the mourning for Hadad Rimmon in the plain of Megiddo."

- Like Israel's mourning at the death of King Josiah
- 2 Chron. 35:24-25
- Deep, widespread, unprecedented

- Intensely Personal Repentance

- cf. Ps. 51:4

"The land shall mourn, each family by itself: the family of the house of David by itself, and their wives by themselves..."

Note: When repentance is too late! Rev. 1:7-8
