"Muttering" 6:41, 61, 7:12,

"These things" 7:25-26, 31

and the chief priests (who were almost all Sadducees) (7:45; 11:47, 57, 18:3)

Acts 23:8 (3-10) "For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor an angel, nor a spirit, but the Pharisees acknowledge them all."

#### and the Pharisees sent officers to seize Him.

"Officers" - (see v. 45-49); 18:3

### "Servants or officers of the Sanhedrin"; "temple guards" Matt. 26:58

Jesus' Statement

<sup>33</sup>Therefore Jesus said,

"For <u>a little while longer</u> I am with you, (approximately 6 months)

then I go to Him who sent Me.

"For a little while longer" – John 12:35; 13:33; 14:19; 16:16-22

Jesus' return to the Father – John 14:12, 28-29; 16:5-10; 16-22, 28; 20:17

<sup>34</sup>"You will seek Me, and will not find Me;

and where I am, you cannot come."

See John 8:21-24; 9:39-41; 15:20-25

# The Jews' Confusion

<sup>35</sup>The Jews then said to one another,

"Where does this man intend to go that we will not find Him?

He is not intending to go to the Dispersion among the Greeks,

and teach the Greeks, is He?

Dispersion – "scattered/scattering abroad" referring to Israelites scattered throughout the Roman Empire. (Also 1Peter 1:1; James 1:1)

<sup>36</sup>"What is this statement that He said,

'You will seek Me, and will not find

Me; and where I am, you cannot come'?"

Like Nicodemus they don't understand. - John 3:4, 9

(also John 6:63)
