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The Test for a Prophet: Agreement with other revealed truth.

<u>Deut. 13:1</u>, "If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a sign or a wonder, <u>Deut. 13:2</u>, "and <u>the sign or the wonder comes to pass</u>, of which he spoke to you, <u>saying</u>, '<u>Let us go after other gods'—which you have not known—'and let us serve them,'</u>

<u>Deut. 13:3</u>, "<u>you shall not listen to the words of that</u> <u>prophet</u> or that dreamer of dreams, for the Lord your God is testing you to know whether you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul." ~NKJV

The Test for a Prophet: Death penalty for failure

<u>Deut. 13:8</u>, "you shall not consent to him or listen to him, nor shall your eye pity him, nor shall you spare him or conceal him;

<u>Deut. 13:9</u>, "but you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to <u>put him to death</u>, and afterward the hand of all the people.

Deut. 13:10, "And you shall stone him with stones until he dies, because he sought to entice you away from the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage." ~NKJV

The Test for a Prophet: 100% accuracy

<u>Deut. 18:20</u>, "'But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.'

<u>Deut. 18:21</u>, "And if you say in your heart, 'How shall we know the word which the Lord has not spoken?'—

Deut. 18:22, "when a prophet speaks in the name of the Lord, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the Lord has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him." ~NKJV

What is Prophecy?

The impartation or disclosure of information from a supernatural source (God, Angel of the Lord, angel) to mortals who cannot discover this knowledge through finite human means; a disclosure that goes beyond human cognition, wisdom, or logic. At times God has chosen to make known to His servants, the prophets, information about the future, which is always completely accurate.

1 Sam. 9:9, "(Formerly in Israel, when a man went to inquire of God, he spoke thus: 'Come, let us go to the seer'; for he who is now called a prophet was formerly called a seer.)"

1 Sam. 9:6, "And he said to him, 'Look now, there is in this city a man of God, and he is an honorable man; all that he says surely comes to pass. So let us go there; perhaps he can show us the way that we should go."

Isa. 41:21, "'Present your case,' says the Lord. 'Bring forth your strong reasons,' says the King of Jacob.

Isa. 41:23, "'Show the things that are to come hereafter, that we may know that you are gods; Yes, do good or do evil, that we may be dismayed and see it together.'" ~NKJV

Luke 24:27, "And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself." ~NKJV

What is a Messiah?

קישִּיק. (māšîaḥ) anointed one, appointed one

Χριστός Christos anointed or appointed one

Used of priests, kings, and others whom God appoints to a task; also used of Cyrus, King of Persia, who allowed the exiled Jews to return home, and the pre-fall Satan—the anointed cherub.

Psa. 2:2, "The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,"

<u>Dan. 9:25</u>, "Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem <u>until Messiah</u> the Prince, there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.

<u>Dan. 9:26</u>, "And after the sixty-two weeks <u>Messiah</u> shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined."

Prophecies in the Law, Prophets, and Writings

Prophecies in the Torah, Nevi'im, and Kethuvi'im

Gen. 3:15, "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."

Gen. 3:14, "So the LORD God said to the serpent: 'Because you have done this, you are cursed more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; On your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life.'"

"THE" Serpent

Always has the Hebrew definite article with it.

Talks, this isn't normal.

Identified in Rom. 16:20; 2 Cor. 11:3 with 11:14; Rev. 12:9

Seems to have inside information about God.

Judged to crawl on his belly and eat dust—a sign of defeat.

Gen. 3:15, "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."

אַיבָּה (*'êbâ*) enmity, hatred.

This Hebrew word always refers to enmity between moral agents.

"seed" אָרֵע (zera) descendant, descendants, offspring (singular or plural)
Can serve as a singular or collective noun.


Gen. 3:15, "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise <u>His</u> heel."

"His heel" 3 masculine singular (3ms) pronoun indicates reference to a male, not a female. His (singular) indicates the representative of the group, not the group.

The Hebrew 3ms pronoun is translated 103 times in the Septuagint (LXX). In 102 of them it correctly agrees with its antecedent referent in gender and number. But in this one exception, when it should be translated as a neuter to refer to the neuter noun *sperma*, it breaks all grammar rules and uses a masculine pronoun "his" rather than "it."

Gen. 9:9, "And as for Me, behold, I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants [seed] after you,"

Gen. 9:25, "Then he said: 'Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants he shall be to his brethren.'

Gen. 9:26, "And he said: 'Blessed be the LORD, the God of Shem, and may Canaan be his servant.

Gen. 9:27, "'May God enlarge Japheth, and may he [or HE] dwell in the tents of Shem; And may Canaan be his slave."

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לכן shakhan Verb qal imperf 3 masc sing jussiveM "to dwell"

Mishkan is the Hebrew for the tabernacle.

In John 1:14

σκηνόω skēnoō 3 sing aor act indic "to dwell in a tent"

Gen. 12:3, "I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Gen. 17:6, "I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you.

Gen. 17:7, "And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you."

Gen. 22:17, "indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed [an individual] shall possess the gate of their [HIS] enemies."

Gen. 49:10, "The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people."

Ezek. 21:24, "Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: 'Because you have made your iniquity to be remembered, in that your transgressions are uncovered, so that in all your doings your sins appear—because you have come to remembrance, you shall be taken in hand.

Ezek. 21:25, " 'Now to you, O profane, wicked prince of Israel, whose day has come, whose iniquity shall end,
