## Ephesians 4; Lord's Day 32 WHY MUST WE STILL DO GOOD WORKS?

## I. The answer.

- A. This question is answered incorrectly.
  - 1. The Arminian (and Pelagian) says good works are necessary to be saved.
  - 2. The Federal Vision position says that good works are necessary in order to stay saved.
  - 3. The Antinomian immediately says that there is no necessity for good works at all (are various degrees of this).
- B. The correct answer.
  - 1. Good works are necessitated by the graciousness of redemption.
  - 2. We are experientially so grateful to God for His blessings.
- II. How can we do good works?
  - A. Objectively, redemption made a real change in us (Eph. 4:17-20,24).
  - B. Subjectively, there are reasons for why believers do good works.
  - C. We cannot be saved without good works.
- III. There are fruits to our good works.
  - A. By his good works the believer is benefitted because he is assured of his faith.
  - B. Others are gained to Christ by our godly conversation (I Peter 3:1; Matt. 5:16).
  - C. Good works praise and thank God, for He saves us for His glory (Rom. 9:23; I Cor. 6:20; Eph. 1:6; I Peter 2:9).
