

The Passover is for:

- **I.** Appreciation "this day shall be unto you..." (vs. 1-2, 14) A Time to:
 - A. Reflect " shall be unto you for a memorial "
 - B. Rejoice "ye shall keep t a feast to the LORD"
 - C. Respect "a feast by an ordinance for ever"
- **II.** Application "they shall take of the blood" (vs. 3-11)

 A Teaching about:
 - **A.** Salvation "take of the blood, and strike it"
 - **B.** Sanctification "they shall eat...unleavened bread"
 - C. Service "with your loins girded...eat it in haste"
- III. Assurance "against all the gods of Egypt...I am" (vs.12-13)

 A Truth that God is:
 - A. Real "I will pass through the land"
 - B. Righteous "I will execute judgment, I am the LORD"
 - C. Resolved "I will pass over you"

Sentence Sermon:

"Salvation is by grace through faith applying the blood of the sinless lamb to our account."
