

**Back to the Future: The Ancient King Like the Coming Antichrist
Daniel 11:21-35

Review:

This passage of ancient history causes us to hope in a yet future day in which the perfect King will rule with complete authority in all the world. The enemies of God are given their appointed times to rule the kingdoms of men, but even in this passage there are promises of the sovereign rule of God and His making all things perfect in the “time appointed.”

Application:

1. The enemies of God are often known for their abuse of power, their use of pretense (deception), and their perversity. Are any of these character traits in your life? Would those who know the “real you” classify you as a “friend of God,” or an “enemy of God?”
2. Vs. 32 includes the phrase, “the people who know their God” – could this phrase be used of you? How well do you know your God? How could you know Him better? What stands in the way of your knowing Him better? Are there some schedule/lifestyle issues that need to change in order for this phrase to be true of you?
3. Based on vs. 35, how might God use a time of “stumbling” in your life? During those times of “stumbling” is it difficult to see God’s sovereign plan?
