"The Shepherd Struck!" Zechariah 13:7-9

The mystery of the cross and the separation it brings across all of history and humanity.

1. The Shepherd Struck!

"Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, against the man who stands next to me."

(1) The Divine Decree

- The death of Christ a divine judicial act
 - The sword: the symbol of judicial power
 - -"Strike the shepherd!" "the stroke that justice gave"

- The death of Christ - a vicarious death

- The sheep deserved the stroke, but the Shepherd receives it

- The death of Christ - a redemptive mystery

- A seeming 'schism' in the Godhead!
- This points up the dreadful evil that sin is!

(2) The Shepherd's Identity

"my shepherd...
the man who stands next to me."

- "My Shepherd"

- God had promised Himself to be the Shepherd to His people Ezek. 34:11ff.
- He promised to punish the false shepherds and to rescue His people Zech. 10:3; 11:17

- A Man!

- Heb: geber = strong man, or a man in his strength
- cf. 6:12 "Behold, the man whose name is the Branch"
 9:6 "Behold, your king is coming to you...humble and mounted on a donkey..."
- Yet more than a Man! "the man who stands next to me"

Heb. 'amith – used for the **nearest kin**; sometimes as synonymous for "brother" KJV "the man (that is) **my fellow**" NAS "the man, **My Associate**" NKJV "the Man who is **My Companion** Other: "the man, **my equal**"

2. The Sheep Scattered and Separated!

vv. 7b-9

(1) A Scattering (7b)

"Strike the shepherd and the sheep will be scattered"

- Its immediate gospel fulfillment Matt. 26:31
- The general dispersion that followed the death of Christ
- (2) A Separation (8)

"In the whole land, declares the LORD, two thirds shall be cut off and perish, and one third shall be left alive."

- -1- A separation of sheep from sheep!
 -The destruction of a majority of the nation
 - "cut off" because of unbelief (cf. Rom. 11)
 - "perish" perish in their unbelief
 - cf. Ezek. 34:17, 22 "I will judge between sheep and sheep"
 - A remnant of Jews separated out across history.
- -2- The preaching of Christ and the cross separates! 1 Pet. 2:6-8
- (3) God's Saving Purpose Advanced (9)

"And I will put this third into the fire, and refine them as one refines silver, and test them as gold is tested."

- -1- The believing remnant lovingly sanctified
- -2- The genuineness of their faith proven
- -3- God's covenant promise fulfilled in them "They will call upon my name, and I will answer them.

I will say, 'They are my people.'; and they will say, 'The LORD is my God.'"
