Lk 24 is fairly well known.

Telephone call – Lk 24 Are you the College Principal? – I pointed out the O.T. usage of "heart."

Gen 1. Most people will say: "I know Gen 1."
Then we find we do not know it nearly as well as we thought

Ps 119 is another familiar portion — 22 divisions (each represents a Heb. letter) 8 verses in each, (22 x8). Each verse has a key word. Each section a word picture — 10th as the number ten represents testing THUS Josh. 23:18:[Why Lam. 3 has 66 verses] (B first letter in OT., L last letter) L for learning, is in 12th section = Gov't.) Mt 5:18; Rev. 1:11;

♣Jn 10 – 5 kinds of sinners

Little word, "so" in Jn 3:16 — extent and Holiness of God's love — (the only begotten, monogenes) = 5 times of Christ. ["in" (eis), is often "into" - the Son.]

Grace, peace. In the context of the Tabernacle we read of the embroidery in blue, purple, and scarlet, as well as sorting out and working in fine linen. These pertain to the Heavenly, the Kingly Redeemer, appearing in spotless Righteousness.

Embroiderers in their sacred task worked with threads of blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen. They had to THINK of minute details as they worked, Mt 4:4. Historical detail, Abraham finds not only PLACE but the TIME of the Lord's death.
