Three Indicators of a Teachable Spirit	 (1) The Danger of Being a mere "Hearer" of the Word (22-24) -1- A common deception! "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."
1. Giving Careful Attention to the Word vv. 19-20 (1) My greatest need at all times! "So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; for the wrath of man does not produce - Quick, eager to give attention to the Word of God the righteousness of God."	 -2- An illustration: A man who looks at himself in a mirror - He sees what is amiss, but immediately forgets what he saw, and so does nothing about it!
