- I. The Dignity Of Work
- II. Ephesians 4:11-13: The Work Of The Kingdom And Its Purpose
 - A. The gifts that Jesus gives to his people (4:11)
 - 1. The apostles
 - 2. The prophets
 - 3. The evangelists
 - 4. The pastors (or shepherds) and teachers
 - B. The reason for these gifts is to help us in our work of ministry (4:12)
 - 1. What is "the work of ministry"?
 - "ministry" = diakonia = "service"
 - 2. The immediate goal of ministry: "for building up the body of Christ."
 - C. The purpose for our work of ministry (4:13)
 - 1. To attain the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God

- 2. To mature manhood
- 3. To the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ
- III. Our Work(s) Of Ministry
 - A. At its heart, ministry is *always* about giving the word of God to others.
 - B. The forms ministry might take:
 - 1. Singing God's word to one another (Eph 5:19)
 - 2. Studying God's word with one another (cf. Dt 6:6-7)
 - 3. Living out/exemplifying God's word before one another (Eph 4:17-24)
 - a. in holy behavior (Eph 4:19-20)
 - b. in acts of mercy and compassion

Start your lifetime of ministry by asking yourself:

"Where in this community of Jesus is the word of God most needed?"

"Where in this community of Jesus and to whom in this community of Jesus can I bring the word of God?"

- 1. What is the role of the apostles, prophets, evangelists, and pastor-teachers?
- 2. Based on Ephesians 4:11-13, what is the work of the kingdom? Who can be considered a minister?
- 3. What does "ministry" mean?
- 4. Based on Ephesians 4:11-13, what are the goals of all-believer ministry?
- 5. "Since all believers are called to give the word of God to others, all believers should be allowed to preach." Discuss. (see Col 3:16; 2 Tim 2:2)
- 6. "Since all believers are called to minister, a church has no need for pastors." Discuss.
- 7. Where in the church can your service be used? How can you prepare for that service?
