THE PROMISE CONCEIVED Luke 1:26-55

What to do with shocking information...

- Joseph gave a silent message
- Mary gave a **submissive** message
- 1) God's Word you must believe it.
 - a) What God says to us might be confusing (v. 29).
 - b) What God says to us might cause fear (v. 30).
 - c) What God says to us might <u>create questions</u> (v. 34). Mary's question sets an example: you can ask God questions about <u>how He does things</u>, but you can't question God about what He does (Romans 9:20).

Note two reasons for virgin birth..

- (a) The problem of original sin.
- (b) The prophecy of <u>virgin birth</u>. It had to be...
- 2) God's Will you just surrender to it.
 - a) What God plans may change your plans (v. 26-27).
 - b) What God plans may change your social standing.
 - c) What God plans may challenge your understanding (v. 35).

- 3) God's Worship you just rejoice in God's favor.
 - a) Worship is preceded by faith and obedience.
 - b) Worship is experienced in **finding favor.**
 - i) God was **in Mary** (v. 28).
 - ii) Mary was in God (v. 46-47).
 - c) Worship is expressed in **full submission** to His will.

But is the promise conceived in you?

<u>Colossians 1:27-29</u> - To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. ²⁸ Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ To this end I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily.
