God Has Acted In Remembrance Of His Mercy Promised To His People, (vs. 1: 54 – 55)

- God revealed the birth of the Child of mercy to those who were unacceptable in the world, (vs. 8 20)
 - A. God's revelation of the Child of mercy is given to those whom God chooses, (vs. 8 14); "But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life." (Titus 3:4–7, ESV)

B. God's revelation of the Child of mercy is received with gladness by those whom God has chosen, (vs. 15 – 20); "In that day the deaf shall hear the words of a book, and out of their gloom and darkness the eyes of the blind shall see. The meek shall obtain fresh joy in the LORD, and the poor among mankind shall exult in the Holy One of Israel." (Isaiah 29:18–19, ESV)
