 - 2) Events involving Timing-- right people, right place, right time

The Miracle at Bethlehem

A. The Miracle of the "Timing": People, Place, Time --2:1-5

- 1. "In the days of Caesar Augustus" -- 2:1
- 2. "The decree to register for taxation" -- 2:1-3
 - a. Problems with the first census of Quirinius
 - 1) Stated: 6AD-- too late for birth of Christ
 - 2) Solutions
 - a) Earlier governorship of Syria
 - b) Registration began earlier; taxes collected later
 - c) Word "first" can be translated "before"-- an earlier census-- Acts 5:37
 - b. Why did they have to return to their hometown?
 - 1) Not the 'head tax'
 - 2) Headache of figuring tax liability
 - a) OT laws regarding land ownership-- Lev 25:23
 - b) Only way for Rome to find owner
- 3. Joseph and Mary "went up to Bethlehem" -- 2:4-5
 - a. Bethlehem as the "city of David"-- 1 Sam 20:6; 17:15
 - b. Miracle: Joseph and Mary are together-- Matt 1:18-25
 - 1) Joseph's decision to divorce-- 1:18-19
 - 2) God's command to Marry-- 1:20-23
 - 3) Joseph's obedience-- 1:24
 - 4) Technically still his 'espoused wife'-- 1:25
- 4. **Miracle**: Mary and Joseph are in the right place at the right time to fulfill the prophecy of Micah 5:2
