## Joshua: A Successful Servant Joshua 1:1

- What is the key to greatness in God's sight? A key to greatness is being a servant.
   How can we be a successful servant?
- Joshua 1:1 says Joshua was "Moses' minister." We see at least three examples of how Joshua served Moses and became an incredibly successful servant:
- 1. His **FIGHT** for God, Exodus 17:8-16

Psalm 3:6; "I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set themselves against me round about.

Romans 8:37; We are more than conquerors through Him that loved us.

2. His FELLOWSHIP with God, Exodus 33:9-11

Exodus 24:13; And Moses rose up, and his minister Joshua; and Moses went up into the mount of God.

Exodus 33:11; And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

- 3. His **FOCUS** on God, Numbers 13,14
- Joshua refused to be intimidated and kept his focus on the LORD, the LAND, and the LESSONS he would learn as he followed the Lord.
- 4. His **FULLNESS** of the Spirit of God, Numbers 27:18; Deut.34:9
