The Consequences of the Fall Genesis 3:8-24 December 20, 2015

Main Point:

In light of the consequences of Adam's fall, look to the One who came to deliver you from them.

1. Because of Adam's fall, you became a guilty sinner before God.

- 2. Because of Adam's fall, you experience resistance to fulfilling your God-given roles.
- 3. Because of Adam's fall, you have lost the ability to save yourself.
- 4. Because of Adam's fall, you are graciously given a Savior to deliver you from these consequences.
- 5. In light of the consequences of Adam's fall, look to the One who came to deliver you from them.
