Sermon: Two Things to See To

Scripture: Hebrews 12:14-29 (text: v. 14-17; 25-29)

Introduction: v. 15a, 25a

- I. See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God (v. 15a):
 - A. Pursue sanctification without which no one will see the Lord (v. 14; Luke 13:22-27).
 - B. Two warning examples:
 - 1. A root of bitterness (v. 15; Col. 3:19; James 3:15)
 - 2. Immorality and godlessness (v. 16-17)
- II. See to it that you do not refuse Him who is speaking (v. 25):
 - A. There is no way to escape the judgment of God for those who won't listen (Hebrews 1:1-3; 2:1-4).
 - B. There is an unshakeable kingdom for those who do listen (v. 26-28; Haggai 2:7-9).
 - C. The person who appreciates the unshakeable kingdom should be a person of a thankful heart and acceptable service (v. 28-29; Romans 12:1-2).
