DEADLY PROCRASTINATION-LOST OPPORTUNITY Acts 24

How opportunity is lost:

- 1. You might evade the **facts**. (v.22-23).
- 2. You might **shut down** the work of the Holy Spirit. (v.24-25a) Listen Felix.
 - a. You have to do something about **yesterday's sin** righteousness.
 - b. You have to do something about today's **sinful habits** self-control.
 - c. You have to do something about tomorrow's **iudgment** (Acts 17:31; Heb 9:27; Jude 14-15).
- 3. You might be tempted to **delay** a decision (v.25b) Indecision is a **decision**.
- 4. You might **desire** something else (v.26-27).
 - a. You might trade <u>gold</u> for God. You might trade the hope of eternity for the hope of <u>money</u>.

Mt 16:26: "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?"

b. You seek the approval of **people** more than the **forgiveness** of God.

<u>2 Cor. 6:2</u>: "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation."
