## Main Point:

Jesus Christ has come to bring restoration to our brokenness; therefore, look to Him for healing and joyfully give praise to Him before others.

1. We are all broken people living in a broken world.

2. But Jesus has come to bring restoration to our brokenness.

3. This is because He is the promised Christ of the Old Testament.

4. To be given this restoration, you must repent and believe in Him.

5. If you have been given this restoration, you should then joyfully give praise to Him.
