- **Christ crucified must be at the center of everything at GBC**

*Christ we proclaim (Col. 1:28); The word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God (1 Cor. 1:18); Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified (1 Cor. 1:22-23); I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified (1 Cor. 2:2).*

“But perhaps he uses the singular (‘who ...?’) because behind these false teachers he detects the activity of the devil himself, the deceiving spirit, whom the Lord Jesus called ‘a liar and the father of lies’ (Jn. 8:44). Much of our Christian [foolishness] in grasping and applying the gospel may be due to the spells which he casts.”<sup>1</sup>

“Remember that Christian doctrine is the battlefield where the most intense spiritual warfare takes place.”<sup>2</sup>
