The Seventh Trumpet

Rev. 11:14-19

The second woe is past. Behold, the third woe comes quickly (14).

1. The three woes (8:13)
The first woe is the fifth trumpet (9:1-12)
The second woe is the sixth trumpet (9:13-21)
2. The second vision of woe is past, the third is about to come.
This picks up where 9:21 ended.
The interlude of 10-11, which interrupts the three woes.
The second woe is the sixth trumpet.
The third woe is the seventh trumpet (11:14)
3. The last Trumpet (7th) is the end of the age and final judgment.

I. The Seventh Angel Sounds His Trumpet (15)

- A. The seventh trumpet
Rev. 10:7 (the mystery is finished)
- B. Loud voices in heaven, which said,
- C. “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ (Messiah) and He will reign forever and ever.”

II. The Twenty-Four Elders Worship (16-18)

- A. The twenty-four elders were seated in the thrones before God
- B. They fell on their faces and worshiped God, saying
- C. Thanks for God’s reign
- D. Thanks for God’s judgment
 1. The nations were enraged
Psa. 2:1
 2. Your wrath came
God’s outpouring of wrath marks the end (6:16-17; 14:10-11; 16:19; 19:15)
 3. The time came for the dead to be judged
Final judgment (Rev. 20:11-15)

4. The time came to reward Your bondservants
The prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name
The small and the great
His slaves are rewarded, and they rejoice.
6:10; 11:18; 19:2
5. And to destroy those who destroy the earth
Rev. 19:2

III. The Temple in Heaven is Opened (19)

- A. The temple of God which is in heaven was opened
- B. The ark of the covenant appeared in His temple
- C. There were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder and an earthquake and a great hailstorm

Conclusion

The reign of God in Christ in His eternal Kingdom will be glorious.
The wrath of God in Christ for those outside the kingdom will be terrifying.
