Children's Sermon: What Kills the Joy of Our Salvation?

Galatians 5:22

But *the fruit of the Spirit* is love, *joy*, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness...

James 1:14–15; 4:3 (HCSB)

¹⁴ But each person is tempted when he is drawn away and enticed by his own *evil desires*. ¹⁵ Then after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin, and when sin is fully grown, it gives birth to death. ...

³ You ask and don't receive because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your *evil desires*.

What Makes a Desire 'Evil'?

Heat

✓ The desire itself is Evil

✓ You are willing to sin to get it

Fruit

✓ You get into sin because you can't get

Heart

Psalm 51:6-12

⁶ Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart. ⁷ Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. ⁸ *Let me hear joy and gladness*; let the bones that you have broken *rejoice*. ⁹ Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. ¹⁰ *Create in me a clean heart*, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. ¹¹ Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. ¹² *Restore to me the joy of your salvation*, and uphold me with a *willing spirit*.

- 2. Hold onto **Hope**
- 3. Provoke into **Love**
- 1. Hold onto **Evil Desires** (False hope)
- 2. Provoke Sin (Attitudes & Actions, bad fruit)
- 3. Hide in **Unbelief** (False faith)

Key Idea

We are either gaining gospel momentum leading to righteousness and life or we are snowballing down into disobedience and death.

Remember the Joy of Eternal Life

Matt. 5:12 "Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven..."

We Are in Need of Endurance

Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. ³⁶ For you have need of endurance...

The Joy of the Holy Spirit

1 Thessalonians 1:6

⁶ And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit...

Romans 5:2b-5

...we rejoice in *hope of the glory of God*. ³ Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, 4 and endurance produces *character*¹, and character produces *hope*, ⁵ and hope does not put us to shame, because God's

James 1:2-4

² Count it all <u>joy</u>, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, ³ <u>for</u> you know that the <u>testing</u> (character) of your faith produces <u>steadfastness</u>. ⁴ And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Joy Grows Out of Faith, Hope & Love

Key Question

How do we cultivate gospel growth or gain gospel momentum leading to righteousness, joy and eternal life?

Do Not Throw Away Your Faith Hope & Love

Therefore do not throw away your <u>confidence</u>, which has a <u>great reward</u>. For <u>you have need of endurance</u>, so that when you have <u>done</u> the will of <u>God</u> you may <u>receive what is promised</u>. For, "Yet a little while, and the coming one will come and will not delay; ³⁸ but my righteous one shall <u>live</u> by <u>faith</u>, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him." ³⁹ But we are not of those who <u>shrink back</u> and <u>are destroyed</u>, but of those who <u>have faith</u> and <u>preserve their souls</u>.

Tend Your Heart with The Word & The Spirit

Proverbs 4:23 (HCSB)

Guard your heart above all else, for it is the source of <u>life</u>.

1st Pray (Trusting God)

Psalm 139:23–24 (HCSB)

²³ **Search me, God**, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns. ²⁴ See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way.

2nd Obey God/Jesus

John 15:7-11

⁷ If you abide in me, and *my words abide in you*, <u>ask</u> whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ <u>By</u> <u>this</u> my Father is glorified, <u>that you bear much fruit</u>

and so prove to be my disciples. ⁹ As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. ¹⁰ If you *keep my commandments*, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you, *that my joy may be in you*, and that *your joy may be full*.

Jeremiah 17:5–10 (Cf. Three Trees Diagram)

⁵ Thus says the Lord:

"Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart turns away from the Lord. 6 He is like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see any good come. He shall dwell in the parched places of the wilderness, in an uninhabited salt land.

⁷ "Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose trust is the Lord. ⁸ <u>He is like a tree planted by water</u>, that sends out its roots by the stream, and does not fear when heat comes, for its leaves remain green, and is not anxious in the year of drought, for it does not cease to bear fruit."

⁹ The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it? ¹⁰ "I the Lord search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds"

Prayerfully tend to the desires of your heart. **Believe** the <u>Truth</u>, **Trust** in the <u>Promised Life</u> & **Follow** the <u>Way of Love</u>. This is where <u>Christian Joy</u> & is found.
