## 2137 - ZACHARIAS and CHRIST'S BIRTH - Luke 1.1-38

PRELIMS. Luke wrote this to Theophilus – but Luke **knew** it would circulate to **all cultures**, so he bore that in mind! Luke was **not** a Jew! (It is reckoned he was born in Macedonia but lived in Antioch in **Syria** and trained as a doctor in Philippi!) So he knew what it was like to be an **outsider** to the Covenant people of God. He gives **prominence** to Gentiles, Samaritans, children, tax-collectors, and those regarded as 'outcasts' in Israel. **Women** have a high profile, Mary, Elizabeth, Anna in earlier chapters and at Christ's burial! **APP** Maybe you are an 'outsider' – or maybe you **feel** like one!

Now it seems many people had already written about Jesus for many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things that Jesus did [1], but Luke obviously felt he should add or maybe correct what was written or been said about Jesus' great works! We do know that Theophilus, and others, needed reassurance that you may have certainty concerning the things you have been taught [4]. God moved Luke, who had having followed all things closely relating to Christ, to write to give us confidence about the facts of X's life/death/resurrection. God does not want us to have any doubts about the Truth! APP So the work of the Church is to reassure people, to strengthen faith in the Truth! What an opportunity we have at Xmas!

## **ZACHARIAS**

This is John Baptist's Father! A **Priest!** He married a Levite of the daughters of Aaron [5] they were both righteous before God walking blamelessly in all the commandments [6]! <u>APP</u> It is possible to be in the Church and **not** righteous before God! Being in a good family line is so helpful, but what is important is not your family line, not your membership lines, but your walk with God! walking blamelessly in all the commandments and statutes of the Lord [6].

History **repeats** itself - like **Abraham** and **Sarah** - they had no family! *But they had no child, because Elizabeth was barren, and* 

both were advanced in years [7c] In **that** culture, looked on as a judgement or reproach [25]! All mothers in Israel wanted to contribute to the 'growth' of Israel both numerically and spiritually.

If Zacharias lived in the UK today he would probably be in the Church of England! They have liturgical readings in rotation going through the complete Bible serving as priest...when his division was on duty, according to the custom of the priesthood, he was chosen by lot to enter the temple of the Lord and burn incense [8,9]

One day as he was engaged in his duties he got a **terrible fright!** there **appeared** to him an **angel** of the Lord [12] **unexpectedly!** Angels **always** do come unexpectedly! And as is **usually** the case, Zacharias was **afraid!** he was **troubled** [12].

Secular authors and **artists** have coloured our thinking! Angels are **not** 'cute, cuddly, dimple on cheek, wings on their backs', lovely little creatures! Seraphim = to **burn** as Isaiah in Temple, touched his lips with a **burning** coals! *I am undone*! Cherubim guarded Tree of Life with a **flaming sword**! Angel of Lord **killed** 70,000 Israelites for David's sin![2Sam24:15]. Angel of the Lord **killed** 185,000 Assyrians through the night [2Kin 19:35]! The **history** of angels appearing to mankind was **not** a pleasant experience!!

Not surprising Z was *trouble*...and *fear* came upon him [12] But Do not be afraid [13] For your prayer has been heard [13] What prayer? The prayer he and Elizabeth had made many years ago – for a child—when they were within the years of child-bearing!! <u>APP</u> I believe both of them had given up hope! It just wasn't God's will for them!! Be careful! Remember Hannah – she was distressed also. It was not until she promised to give Samuel 'back to God' did God grant her a child! She had to come to the point where she really believed children are God's heritage - they belong to God not us!

## **The CHILD – JOHN BAPTIST**

Two 'wonderful' things about this child! He will be filled with the

Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb! [15] Note: we are a person in the womb, and it seems we can be regenerated there also! Several saints – Moses parents saw he was a proper child, something 'special'!; Samson a Nararite to God from the womb [Jud 13:5]; David You (God) made me trust You at my mother's breasts...On You was I cast from my birth, and from my mother's womb You have been my God [Psa 22:9,10]; Jeremiah Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations [Jer 1:5]; John Baptist! Regenerated from the womb! Can still happen today – I've met with people who 'fell in love with Jesus the 1st time they heard of him and never remember hating God'! We must portray a correct image of God particularly to children. It is easy for children to believe – so feed them the Truth – particularly about God's love to them!

2nd, his ministry - to turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God [16] in preparation for the coming of Christ! to make ready for the Lord a people prepared [17]. This means that there needs to be some 'preparation' for Christ! John's ministry was convicting people of sin! Unless you realise that you are a sinner, and that sin deserves eternal death, Christ is not going to be very relevant, is He? Why bother about Jesus if He is not a Saviour from danger? Have you wondered why the OT is 3 times as large as NT? Because it has important information – for the preparation of the gospel! Whatever you may think about John, his dress, decorum, boldness, sermons, he did turn many to God – he did prepare Israel for Christ! 'Dare to be different'! \*\*Surprisingly(?) he also instigated family reunions! to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children [17]! This 'loner', this 'maverick' in the wilderness had Truth and it is the Truth, not the 'channel' that gives blessing!

How shall I know this? For I am an old man [18] Perfectly reasonable question – yet it seemed to have **grieved God!** "...behold you shall be **silent** and **unable to speak** because you did **not believe** my words [20]! **Seems** a **harsh** judgment! **APP** God **seriously** wants

us to **believe** His Word! Here is just a 'little reminder' that God the big sin is not so much that we disbelieve in hell - but that we disbelieve the Good News, the Gospel of Jesus Christ! It was *this Good News* that Zacharias refused to believe![19]!

The Bible **focuses** its attention on the **blessings** God wants to give us – not on the awful judgement awaiting the unrepentant! The **incentive** God gives is **not** 'fear' of judgement but **reward** for obedience! No mention of Hell in OT (Sheol = 'place of the dead', not the eternal flames!) Hell was a **gradual** revelation! What is God's **first** communication to Abraham and Israel? Was it a message of 'Unless you repent you are bound for Hell' attitude? No! It is an attitude of **mercy** and **promise** of **life** everlasting! 'Move out of here and I will give you a great land for your possession!' Ie 'I'll give you a better life, home, friends, family'! It seems to **fail** to **believe** the **Good News** God has to give, is **more reprehensible** than failing to believe about His judgements on sinners!

## **CHRIST'S BIRTH**

God sent Gabriel **again** on a **similar** mission 6 months later to another woman – a virgin! *In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was* **sent** from **God**...to a **virgin** [26] This time he spoke to the mother herself! And actually, she too was **afraid** and had **questions** to ask! she was **greatly troubled** at the saying... **How** will this be? [29 + 34]. Again a perfectly legitimate question! And Gabriel explains!

you will... bear a Son...miraculously! The Holy Spirit will come upon you Mystery! What faith Mary had! (1) and you shall call His name <u>Jesus</u> [31] The name means Hosea='save'! Jesus saves people! (2) He will reign... forever [33] He will never stop reigning! He is reigning now! (3) He is the Son of God [35] Heresy! Mystery! Faith again! X's kingdom will never be destroyed! After 2,000 years it has only just begun! The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord [Rev 11:15] APP So do not be discouraged if you cannot understand things in the Word of God!!
