- III. THE JUDGMENT OF THE NATIONS Matt 25:31-46
 - A. Those who survived the last days who did not take the mark of the beast
 - B. Reward for those who cooperated with God's work
 - C. Punishment for those with no mercy for God's persecuted refugees

IV. THE JUDGMENT OF REBELLIOUS ANGELS 1 Cor 6

- A. These are the angels and their troops who followed them who once occupied seats as the divine council members; they lost those positions in the war
- B. The church, sons of God (Rom 8:19-23), are the new members of the reconstituted divine council; they are the image of Christ on this council
- C. As the first council, the watchers, judged humans on earth now these resurrected humans in the image of Christ will judge the angels who rebelled
- D. The lake of fire awaits the angels who rebelled; it was prepared for them Matt 25:41
- V. A NEW MILLENNIAL TEMPLE IS BUILT AND THE PROMISED LAND DIVIDED UP Ezek 40-48
 - A. This is the temple on EARTH in the New Jerusalem
 - B. This is NOT the same as the New Jerusalem descending toward earth the bride of Christ
 - C. This is NOT the temple built and used during the Tribulation
 - D. This IS the temple used by the new, long-living

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residents of earth enjoying the earth as it was intended in the beginning

- VI. REWARDS FOR FAITHFULNESS AND SERVICE MANY PARABLES ON ACCOUNTABILITY
 - A. Works by covenanted people are examined and rewarded by the LORD Matt 25:14-30
 - 1. Only given to His servants, those identifying with His household, in His covenant, Israel and those converting to it, claiming the exceptionalism of being a part of the covenant
 - 2. The church has already been judged at the judgment seat of Christ: the righteous standard was the same, but the object was different
 - 3. From the beginning the standard has been faith followed by stewardship with what one was given; faith made one a servant of God; stewardship is the work of a servant of God
 - 4. The standard is not in comparison to others but how one handled what he had been given
 - 5. Work: faithful in what one is given; reward: faithful in little, faithful in much
 - B. Foolish stewardship or wicked stewardship was proof of no faith in the Master, therefore a false servant and not a part of the Master's household
 - 1. How can one identify with the Master's household and be cast out to outer darkness?
 - 2. All those not in the household perish eternally; to be judged at the Great White Throne
