WILL BE BORN OF A DAVIDIC VIRGIN

Isaiah 7:14

¹⁴Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Luke 1:26–31

WILL HAVE A GALILEAN MINISTRY

Isaiah 9:1–2

¹But there shall be no gloom to her that was in anguish. In the former time he brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali; but in the latter time hath he made it glorious, by the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations. ²The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Matthew 4:13–16

WILL BE AN HEIR TO THE THRONE OF DAVID AND THE DAVIDIC COVENANT

Isaiah 9:6–7

⁶For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷Of the increase of his government and of peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of Jehovah of hosts will perform this (ASV, 1901).

Isaiah 11:1, 10

¹And there shall come forth a shoot out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch out of his roots shall bear fruit ¹⁰And it shall come to pass in that day, that the root of Jesse,

that standeth for an ensign of the peoples, unto him shall the nations seek; and his resting-place shall be glorious (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Luke 1:32–33; Romans 15:12; Revelation 22:16

WILL HAVE HIS WAY PREPARED

Isaiah 40:3–5

³The voice of one that crieth, Prepare ye in the wilderness the way of Jehovah; make level in the desert a highway for our God. ⁴Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the uneven shall be made level, and the rough places a plain: ⁵and the glory of Jehovah shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of Jehovah hath spoken it (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Matthew 3:3; Mark 1:2–3; Luke 1:76; John 1:19–28

WILL BE SPAT ON AND STRUCK

Isaiah 50:6

⁶I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair; I hid not my face from shame and spitting (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Matthew 26:67

WILL BE EXALTED

Isaiah 52:13

¹³Behold, my servant shall deal wisely, he shall be exalted and lifted up, and shall be very high (ASV, 1901).

John 12:32; Philippians 2:9–11

WILL BE DISFIGURED BY SUFFERING

Isaiah 52:14

¹⁴Like as many were astonished at thee (his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men) (ASV, 1901).

Isaiah 53:10

¹⁰Yet it pleased Jehovah to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of Jehovah shall prosper in his hand (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Matthew 27:29–30; Mark 15:15–19; Luke 22:63; John 19:1–3

WILL BE WIDELY REJECTED

Isaiah 53:1–3

¹Who hath believed our message? and to whom hath the arm of Jehovah been revealed? ²For he grew up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. ³He was despised, and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and as one from whom men hide their face he was despised; and we esteemed him not (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in John 12:27–38

WILL BEAR OUR SINS AND SORROWS

Isaiah 53:4–5

⁴Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows; yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. ⁵But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Romans 4:25; II Corinthians 5:21; I Peter 2:24–25

GOD'S SPIRIT WILL REST ON HIM

Isaiah 11:2

²And the Spirit of Jehovah shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Jehovah (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Matthew 3:16; Mark 1:10; Luke 3:22; 4:1

GENTILES WILL SEEK HIM

Isaiah 11:10

¹⁰*And it shall come to pass in that day, that the root of Jesse, that standeth for an ensign of the peoples, unto him shall the nations seek; and his resting-place shall be glorious (ASV, 1901).*

Fulfilled in Luke 2:30–32

WILL MAKE A BLOOD ATONEMENT

Isaiah 53:5

⁵*But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed (ASV, 1901).*

Fulfilled in John 19:34; Acts 13:28; Romans 8:3; I Peter 1:2

WILL VOLUNTARILY ACCEPT OUR GUILT AND PUNISHMENT FOR SIN WITHOUT OPENING HIS MOUTH LIKE A LAMB LED TO SLAUGHTER

Isaiah 53:7

⁷*He was oppressed, yet when he was afflicted he opened not his mouth; as a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and as a sheep that before its shearers is dumb, so he opened not his mouth (ASV, 1901).*

Fulfilled in Matthew 27:14; Luke 23:9; John 1:29; Acts 8:32; Romans 6:10; II Corinthians 5:21; I Peter 2:23

WILL BE OUR SUBSTITUTE

Isaiah 53:6,8

⁶*All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and Jehovah hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. ⁸By oppression and judgment he was taken away; and as for his generation, who among them considered that he was cut off out of the land of the living for the transgression of my people to whom the stroke was due (ASV, 1901)?*

Fulfilled in Romans 5:6, 8; II Corinthians 5:21

WILL BEAR THE SINS OF MANY FOR THE SAKE OF THEIR SALVATION

Isaiah 53:12

¹²Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he poured out his soul unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors: yet he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Romans 4:25; Hebrews 9:28

WILL DIE WITH TRANSGRESSORS

Isaiah 53:12

¹²Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he poured out his soul unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors: yet he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Matthew 27:38; Mark 15:27–28; Luke 22:37, 22:33

WILL HEAL THE BROKENHEARTED

Isaiah 61:1–2a

The Spirit of the Lord Jehovah is upon me; because Jehovah hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; ²to proclaim the year of Jehovah's favor (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in Luke 4:18–19

WILL BE BURIED IN A RICH MAN'S TOMB

Isaiah 53:9

⁹And they made his grave with the wicked, and with a rich man in his death; although he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in matthew 27:57–60; John 19:38–42

HE WILL JUDGE THE EARTH WITH RIGHTEOUSNESS

Isaiah 11:4–5

⁴but with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth; and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. ⁵And righteousness shall be the girdle of his waist, and faithfulness the girdle of his loins (ASV, 1901).

Fulfilled in John 5:27; Luke 19:22; II Thessalonians 2:5–8; II Timothy 4:1,8; Revelation 19:11, 15
