

From Child to Conqueror

Revelation 19:1-21

- 1) Christ was born; He lived, died, rose, and ascended to heaven
- 2) Hallelujah! Christ will come again (Rev. 19; cf. Deut.32:43; Ps. 48:11; 96:11-13)
 - a) He will conquer evil, meting out justice (19:1-2; cf. Isa. 9:6-7; Jer. 23:5; 2 Thess. 1:6-8)
 - b) He will reign over all creation (19:3-6)
 - c) He will marry His bride, the Church (19:7-8; cf. Eph. 5:27)
 - d) We will celebrate our Master, not a menu (19:9; cf. Matt. 26:29)
- 3) Jesus is the “spirit of prophecy” (10)
 - a) He will return as the conquering King (19:11-13; cf. Matt. 24:27-31)
 - i) Judging in righteousness
 - ii) Waging war against His enemies
 - b) He comes with His entourage of holy ones (19:14): raptured saints, Tribulation martyrs, OT believers, and angels
 - c) He will rule the world as King of kings, Lord of lords (19:15-16)
 - d) His victory is accomplished with a “word” (19:17-21)
- 4) Applications and observations
 - a) Only those who trust in Christ will be spared His wrath
 - b) No other name under heaven can save us, only Christ (Acts 4:12; cf. Phil. 2:10)
 - c) All others, kings and otherwise, will be dethroned by Christ
