- 2. Have the right plan and goal... i.e. Sanctification...
- a. It is God's will for you...
- b. It is God's work of grace, whereby, He delivers you consciously from the corruption and dominion of sin... *Ephesians 2: 10*
- c. It's an imperative...
- d. It's goal; to be found by Christ...
- 1. At peace... Romans 5:1ff; Philippians 1:10; I Thessalonians 3:13; 5:23
- 2. Without spot or blemish... James 1:27; Philippians 2:15
