

God's Son Born Unto Us

Psalm 2:1-12

- 1) Man is born in sin, rebelling against God (2:1-3)
 - a) He is angry, in rebellion from his birth
 - b) He's hatching an empty plan to save himself
 - c) He finds solace w/ other unbelieving scoffers
 - d) Denying God, he seeks to "do as thou wilt"
- 2) God in heaven sees & hears everything man does & thinks (2:4-6)
 - a) He is unmoved by man's rebellion
 - b) He currently scoffs at those who mock Him
 - c) He will speak judgment against them
 - d) He will reign on Mt. Zion
- 3) Christ, the eternal God, will reign over all the earth (2:7-9)
 - a) By His Father's decree, the Son became man
 - b) The Son will inherit the Father's possessions
 - c) He will shatter all rebels like clay pots
- 4) The Spirit calls us to repentance unto salvation (2:10-12)
 - a) Act wisely toward the Creator
 - b) Worship God for His goodness w/ joyful exuberance
 - c) Receive God's Son, and be blessed
