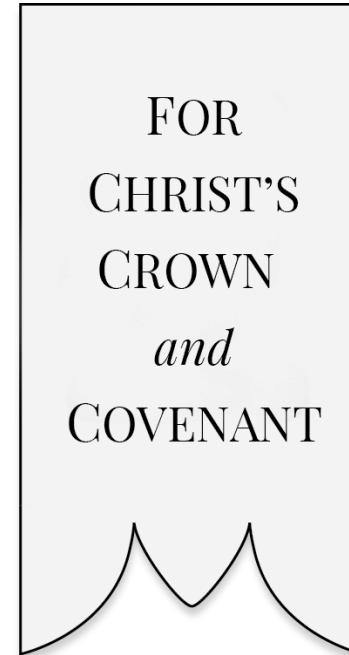

### CONFESSION OF FAITH XVII. *Of the Perseverance of the Saints*
