"A Final Word"

Acts 20:17-32

The Apostle's heart, pattern, and strategy in ministry: A lesson for the Church for all time.

- 1. The Over-arching Strategy
 - (1) <u>Initial</u>: (Especially the work of an evangelist or church-planter)
 - -1- Preaching the Gospel in the Synagogue On Saturdays for 3 months cf. Acts 19:8-10
 - A natural "door of opportunity"
 - Opposition arose; those who were disciples were taken aside.

-2- Discipleship in the School of Tyrannus - approximately 2 years

- During the "siesta" period of the day (Some mss: "from the 5th hour to the 10th")
- Paul stayed in Ephesus while co-laborers carried on church-planting in neighboring cities
- Churches established in Colossae, Hierapolis, Laodicea
- All seven of the churches of Asia (Revelation 2-3) founded at this time (?).

Result: "all the residents of Asia heard the word of the Lord, both Jews and Greeks" (19:10)

(2) <u>On-going</u> - The church further established during this same period of time

-1- A Full-Orbed Pastoral Ministry

- Humility and earnestness (20:19) (Self-sacrifice! cf. vv. 33-35) "I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you in public and from house to house"

- Public preaching and teaching in the regular gathering of the saints (v. 20, cf. v. 25) "declaring...teaching" "proclaiming the kingdom"
- Close personal instruction and application privately "from house to house"
- Continued evangelism "testifying both to Jews and to Greeks of repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ."

-2- Elders had been Trained, Ordained, and Installed (cf. 20:17, 28)

2. The Indispensable Priority: Faithful Preaching and Teaching

(1) This had <u>Established</u> the Church

-1- Paul had faithfully discharged his responsibility (26)

"I am innocent of the blood of all"

- cf. "the watchman" Ezekiel 33:1-9 (esp. 7-9)

-2- Paul had faithfully and fully declared the truth

The Gospel Message v. 21 "repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ"

- "to Jews and also to Greeks" - "the gospel of the grace of God" (24)

The Whole Counsel of God v. 27

- -"I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable" (20)
- "I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole counsel of God."
- "the word of his grace" (32)

(2) This alone can <u>Preserve</u> the Church vv. 28-32

-1- An inevitable attack comes from outside and from within! (29-30)

-2- The means of safety and preservation

- "Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock"
- "be alert" (31a) By continued earnest and heartfelt admonition.
