Grateful Worship
Matthew 2:1-23
Joint Thanksgiving Service at RPC of Columbus
December 1, 2013

Main Point:

Jesus, the faithful Son of God, was despised and rejected for you; therefore, gratefully worship Him, no matter the cost.

1. Jesus is worthy of your worship. (vv. 1-11)

2. As the true Son of God, Jesus was always faithful to the Father on your behalf. (vv. 12-15)

3. As a Nazarene, Jesus was despised and rejected for your sake. (vv. 16-23)

4. Gratefully worship Him, no matter the cost.
