GODLINESS WITH CONTENTMENT: PART I BE READY TO DEAL WITH FALSE TEACHERS

Main Idea: Be ready to deal with false teachers!

- Understand that theirs is a "different doctrine" (heterodoxy) (3)
 - O It is a different doctrine (3)
 - O It does not agree with the sound words of Christ (3)
 - O It does not agree with the teaching that accords with godliness (3)
- Understand their characteristics (4-5)
 - O They are conceited (4)
 - O They understand nothing (4)
 - O Their unhealthy craving for controversy over words, produces...
 - + Envy (4), Strife (4), Abusive speech (4), Evil suspicions (4), Wrangling (constant friction) (5)
 - Among people depraved in mind
 - Among people deprived of the truth
 - O They have a belief in monetary gain through godliness (5)
- Understand the perils of "desiring wealth" (6-10)
 - O There is great gain in godliness with contentment (6)
 - O We brought nothing in, we take nothing out (7)
 - O We need to be content with food and clothing (8)
 - O Those who desire to be rich fall into temptation (9)
 - O Those temptations produce evil desires (9)
 - ✦ That plunge people into ruin (now)
 - ✦ That plunge people into destruction (future)
- Life principle: The love of money is a root of all kinds of evils. (10)
 - O Some have wandered from the faith (future)
 - O Some have pierced themselves with many pangs (now)

Application Love God, or love money?
