Stay Clear Of Carnal Christians

Paul wants Pastor Timothy and all Christians to “*purge himself*” from dishonorable Christians and evil of all kinds that would work against the things of the Lord. We cannot have very close fellowship with Christians who are not living for the Lord and not expect that some of their habits and carnality might be absorbed by us. That is the way things generally go. God wants every born-again Christian to be “*unto honour*” and “*sanctified*” for His “*use,*” being “*prepared unto every good work.*”

Flee Youthful Lusts

If you love flowers you must hate the weeds. Paul told Timothy to “*flee youthful lusts.*” He also told him to “*follow righteousness, faith, charity, and peace.*” Joseph fled from Potiphar's wife's sexual advances (Genesis 39:5-20).
