## Introduction:

Matthew 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many

1 Timothy 3:15 I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.

1 Timothy 3:8 <u>Deacons</u> likewise must be men of dignity, not double-tongued, or addicted to much wine or fond of sordid gain, 9 but holding to the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience. 10 <u>These men</u> must also first be tested; then let them serve as deacons if they are beyond reproach. 11 <u>Women</u> must likewise be dignified, not malicious gossips, but temperate, faithful in all things. 12 <u>Deacons</u> must be husbands of only one wife, and good managers of their children and their own households. 13 For those who have served well as <u>deacons</u> obtain for themselves a high standing and great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.
