Anger is a Gateway Sin



Psa. 119:11, “Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You.”

1. We believe the Bible, and only the Bible, has the answer.

2 Pet. 1:3, “as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,

2 Pet. 1:4, “by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.”

2. Spiritual transformation vs. psychological transformation

**Rom. 12:2, “And do not be pressed into the mold of your culture’s values and methodology, but be transformed by the total renovation of how and what you think, that your life will be evidence that the will of God (what He says in the Bible) is good and acceptable and (perfect) complete.”
~RD paraphrase**

Rom. 12:2, “And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.” ~NKJV

3. The world system, the spirit of the age, which we refer to as human viewpoint, the way of the flesh, is set in direct conflict with the Word of God. Satan vs. God, human viewpoint vs. Divine viewpoint.

Prov. 14:12, “There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death.”

Prov. 14:27, “The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to turn one away from the snares of death.”

Prov. 16:25, “There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death.”

John 14:30, “I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me.”



Rom. 8:13, “For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.”





Soul Fortress Principles

- 1. Construction of the soul fortress takes a lifetime.**
- 2. Construction is piecemeal and dynamic.**
- 3. Utilization of the spiritual skills enables us to stay inside the fortress. Failure to use these skills leaves us outside, vulnerable to damage from sin, the world, and the devil.**
- 4. When we fail to utilize the spiritual skills, we default to the arrogance skills.**

Soul Fortress Principles

5. We either live in the soul fortress, the equivalent of walking by the Holy Spirit (HS), walking in the light, walking in truth, living on the basis of being in Christ (the New Man),

or we are outside, walking according to our sin nature, walking in darkness, living on the basis of the lie, living like we are still in Adam (in the Old Man).


Soul Fortress Principles

Total forgiveness; God forgets, so should we.


Psa. 103:12, “As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.”

#1 Confession of Sin

#2 Filling/Walking “by Means of the Holy Spirit”


Eph. 5:18, “And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with [by means of] the Spirit,
Eph. 5:19, “speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,” ~NKJV

Col. 3:16, “Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.”

Gal. 5:16, “But I say, walk by [means of] the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.”

#2 Filling/Walking “by means of the HS”

When we are walking [living moment by moment] by means of the Holy Spirit, then the HS fills us with the Word of Christ, so that it can richly dwell within us and produce spiritual growth, spiritual transformation, renovate our thinking, and develop the fruit of the Spirit toward the goal of making us like Christ.

#3 Faith-Rest Drill

The believer trusts God to fulfill His promises, relies upon biblical principles, and thinks through doctrinal rationales, resulting in a relaxed mental attitude because God is taking care of the situation.

- Grab a verse or part of a verse**
- Mix it with faith, trusting in God**
- Do what it says to do (mental attitude, communication, behavior)**
- Relax in God's provision and oversight**

Jer. 17:5, “Thus says the LORD: ‘Cursed is the man who has confidence in human beings and their philosophies; And makes flesh his strength, whose heart departs from the LORD.

~RD paraphrase

Jer. 17:6, “ ‘For he shall be like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see when good comes, but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land which is not inhabited.

Jer. 17:7, “ ‘Blessed is the man who confidently trusts in the LORD, and whose confident expectation is the LORD.

Jer. 17:8, “ ‘For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit.’ ”
