CHRIST'S REDEMPTIVE KINGDOM IN BIBLICAL CONTEXT - Rv 11:15 INTRODUCTION

- 1. <u>Rv11:15</u> in the future, on the brink of eternity
- 2. Review last LD: two celebratory events in heaven: v15 & v16-18 [v19] Christ's Redemptive Kingdom & The Kingdom of God [Creator/Judge].
 - i. Surveyed Gen 1-3
 - Redemptive Religion: 1] Gn 3:15 Promised Seed who wld defeat Satan; 2] Gn 3:21 Provision of Sac'al atonement for sin; 3] Gn 3:22-24
 Prospect of Sacred Soil cast out w/ hope of garden; 4] Gn 4:3 Privilege of Sab every 7th day: access & oriented to Sab Rest
 - iii. OT & NT rev: promise/prophesy; type/ antitype; shadow/substance.

1st: Daniel's Prophesy of Christ's Redemptive Kingdom

- **1.** God's covenant w/ Abraham tribal nation of OCov Israel: apostasy. Cov curse exile in Babylon: Daniel.
- 2. Nebuchadnezzar's nightmare Dan interps: <u>Dan 2</u>. Statue symbolizes empires until coming of Messiah's kingdom stone <u>v44-45</u>
- **3**. <u>Dan 7</u> Dan's vision [progressive parallelism same as Dan 2 but includes revelation re: Jesus' enthronement & Church-Age]. Overview
 - i. v18 saints receive the kingdom
 - ii. 4th beast & more detail <u>v21-22</u>.
 - iii. <u>v23-28</u> v27 parallels Rv 11:15
- 4. Dan 8 = vision of conflict & desecration of temple [168BC] $\underline{8:27}$
- 5. Dan 9 = Dan's prayer [Jer 25:11-12 70yr exile]. Gabriel interps chpt 8. Chpt 10's vision ; chpt 11 re-focus on *the Beautiful Land & end of sacrifice* [*abomination of desolation* -11:31]. God's purposes concerns His people.
- 6. Dan 12 prophesy of resurrection [v1ff]; *the end of time* [v4] wh/ requires passing of *a time, times, & 1/2 a time* [v7]. Dan not understand & told to seal up prophesy <u>12:13</u>.

2nd: Jesus' Establishment of His Redemptive Kingdom

- 1. Mat 4:17,23 arrival of Kingdom in person & work of the King Rv 12:5
- 2. A1:3 post-res & pre-ascension [Lk 24:44f]. Kingdom of forgiveness
 - i. <u>A1:6</u> not a earthly kingdom like David/Solomon
 - ii. <u>A8:12</u> kingdom proclaimed in gospel & entered by faith [baptism]
 - iii. <u>A28:31</u> *Kingdom of God* = salvation [v28]

3rd: The Apostle's Proclamation of Christ's Redemptive Kingdom

- 1. Jesus' resurrection proclaimed in Acts; *kingdom* [8x] a synonym of gospel wh/ summons hearers to faith in Christ & to enter His kingdom. See ref's to *kingdom* in Epistles & Revelation.
- 2. <u>1C15</u> rlts to <u>Rv 11:15-17</u>.
 - i. <u>1C15:20-23</u> Jesus, *last Adam* [v45], is Promised seed of Gn3:15 who brings His resurrected people into the glory of God's Sabbath Rest.
 - **ii**. <u>1C15:24-26</u> = conclusion of Christ's mediatorial redemptive reign when last enemy, death, is defeated [Rv 20:14 lake of fire].
 - iii. Jesus reigns redemptively now & is building His church.
 - **iV.** We will be completely conformed to Jesus [Rm 8:29] <u>1C15:27-28</u> Creation, by the obedience of last Adam, enters God's Sabbath Rest
- **3.** $\underline{\text{Rv 11:15-18}} = 2$ hymns of praise for 2 kingdoms: *reign*. $\underline{\text{v19}}$ commencement of Final Judgment. End of 1st 1/2 of Rv.
- **4.** v15 in context of 4 pts of ref: 1] Provisions given to Adam at Fall; 2] Dan's visions; 3] Jesus' ministry; 4] Paul's prophesy in 1 Cor 15.

Applic #1: We Must Understand How the OT and NT Relate to Each Other

- 1. <u>Rv10:7</u> God's revelation will serve God's purposes
- 2. We need to understand how God has revealed His saving grace over the course of Redemptive History; from OT to NT fulfilled in Jesus Christ.

Applic #2: Christ's Redemptive Kingdom Surpasses All Other Kingdoms

- **1.** We are part of the reign of Christ that reaches back to the Fall & forward to the glory of God's eternal Sabbath Rest!
- 2. Blessed is he who does not take offense at Me [Lk7:23]
- **3.** This celebration in Rv11:15 is 'already & not yet' a celebration in wh/ we participate in worship; a victory to wh/ we witness. There is no greater blessing or privilege. He is worthy.
