Introduction:

I. WHY SHOULD I DISCIPLE SOMEONE ELSE?

1. BECAUSE GOD COMMANDS DISCIPLESHIP

2. BECAUSE NEW BELIEVERS NEED DISCIPLING

A. NEW BELIEVERS (like newborn infants) NEED LOVE, PROTECTION, FOOD AND TRAINING

1. They are more vulnerable than mature Christians

2. They have a great potential for growth (change)

B. NEW BELIEVERS NEED TO KNOW WHAT THEY HAVE IN CHRIST (II Cor. 5:17)

C. NEW BELIEVERS NEED TO UNDERSTAND THAT CHRIST IS NOW THE LORD OF THEIR LIVES. (Teach them the Lordship of Christ)

II. HOW SHOULD I DISCIPLE SOMEONE ELSE?

A. **Be all that you need to be with a real love for Jesus Christ (Mt. 22:37)**

B. **Pray fervently for someone to pour your life into (Luke 6:12-13)**

C. **Start developing a relationship & friendship with the fellow-Christian, who God leads you to disciple**

Men disciple men

Women disciple women (Titus 2)

1. Your disciple will need your time & attention (Mk. 3:13-14)

2. Your disciple will need to see your Christ-like Example (I Cor. 4:16, 11:1)

D. **Begin Teaching your Disciple by your words, Character, & Conduct**

Your disciple will need your Training (Matthew 28:19-20)

a. Teach him/her to Glorify God (The Purpose that drives our life)

b. Teach him/her how to establish a daily devotional life

c. Teach him/her how to Think God honoring Thoughts

d. Teach him/her how to Make God honoring Decisions

e. Teach him/her how to become faithfully involved in Church ministry (Acts 2:42, 45-47)

E. **Your disciple will need Accountability**
