4. ...that He be our only comfort in life and death

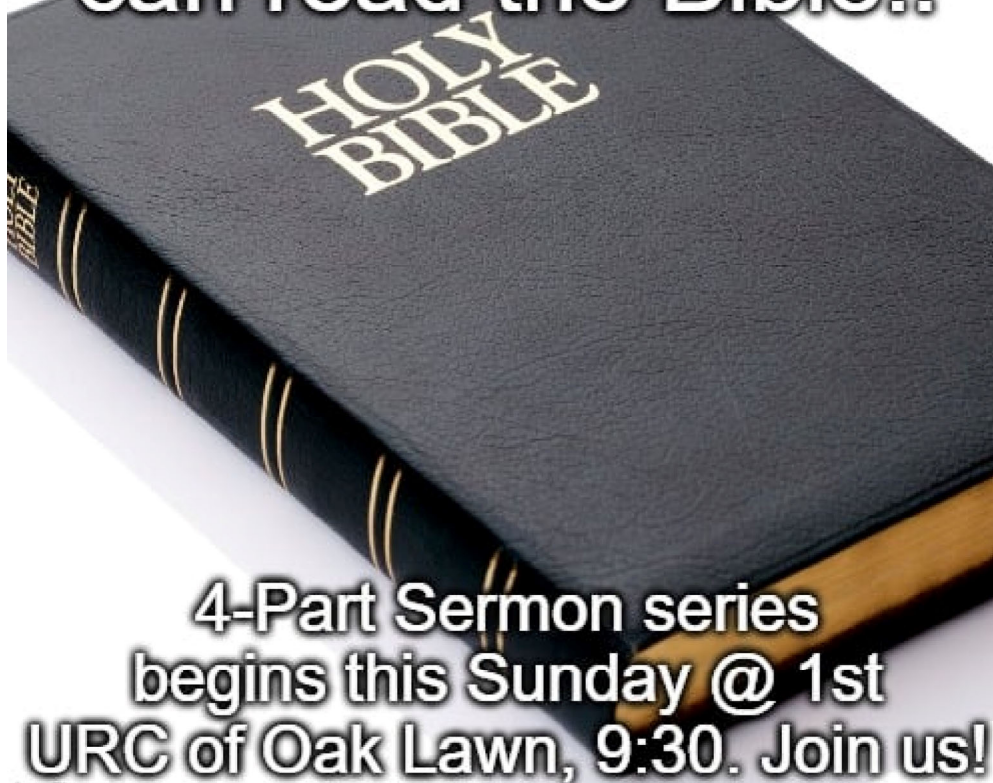
James 3.9, 10 Our Digital Tongue-Print

Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 43

Theme: Our witness about our "neighbors" on social media must help them to glorify God

1. The 9th commandment for today *obviously* includes our use of social media
2. As with other forms of speech, social media can be used to glorify God
3. As social media can also be used to "...curse men"
4. We must be proactive and control reactions to well-use this powerful speech tool
