BEAUTIFUL, FEMININE HAIR

TEXT: 1 Corinthians 11:1 Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.

2 Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you.

3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

4 Every man praying or prophesying, having his head covered, dishonoureth his head.

5 But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with her head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven.

Romans 1:24 Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to <u>dishonour</u> their own bodies between themselves:

Proverbs 3:35 The wise shall inherit glory: but <u>shame</u> shall be the promotion of fools.

Habakkuk 2:16 Thou art filled with shame for glory...

1 Corinthians 15:43 It is sown in <u>dishonour</u>; it is raised in glory...

Proverbs 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter.

1 Corinthians 11:5 But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with her head uncovered **dishonoureth** her head: **for** that is even all one as if she **were shaven**.

6 For if the woman be not covered, let her also be shorn: but if it be a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven, let her be covered.

7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man.
